COURSE DESCRIPTION & OVERALL GOAL

This course will review principles for the diagnosis, treatment, and management of latent TB infection and TB disease and strategies for collaborative care. The format will include lectures and interactive case discussions.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

The course is designed for healthcare providers who are involved in the diagnosis and management of TB patients.

WHY COURSE IS NEEDED

As the incidence of tuberculosis continues to decline, maintaining clinical and public health expertise in TB is particularly challenging. Therefore, ongoing training and education are important for healthcare providers to enhance skills in TB diagnosis, follow recommended treatment guidelines, and interact effectively with public health agencies.

OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, participants should be better able to:

- Recognize the current epidemiological trends in TB at the national and local level
- Integrate appropriate risk-based screening, testing methods, and treatment options for latent TB infection
- Apply current recommendations for the diagnosis and treatment of TB disease to ensure successful outcomes
- Develop strategies to strengthen partnerships for the coordination of TB care and prevention efforts

COURSE REQUIREMENTS
